

NATIONAL SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN

Week of Action: 24th – 28th June 2024

The 10 Safeguarding Children Partnerships have worked together to co-ordinate a programme of events highlighting the importance of safeguarding children. Each session is open to any practitioner who works or volunteers directly or indirectly with children, young people and their families. The sessions are free of charge and all you will need is access to teams/zoom. Attending one of the sessions can contribute towards 'continuing professional development'.

Monday 24th June: Safer Sleeping (Virtual or Face to Face 10:00 – 11:30am)

This session will share learning from Rapid Reviews in Bury, which have focused on safer sleeping in the context of safeguarding. It will include an introduction to the safer sleeping toolkit, which some partnerships also have in Greater Manchester. Tuesday 25th June: Learning from North West Reviews (Virtual 11:00 – 12:30am)

This session will share recent learning from Rapid Reviews across the North West, with a particular focus on Child Sexual Abuse in the Family Environment. The session will also provide an overview of learning from recent national reviews. Wednesday 26th June: Online/E-safety (Virtual 9:30am – 1:00pm)

A journey into the online world which our young people navigate every day. During this ½ day course you will learn about online risks, how to respond to incidents, and how to encourage young people to be safe online. The course considers what young people are doing online, what we should be looking for and how to practically deliver direct work to children and young people. Who should attend? Staff from all agencies who work with children, young people and families in a professional capacity. The course will also be relevant to practitioners working with adults.

Thursday 27th June: Graded Care Profile 2 Training (Trafford Town Hall 9:30 – 16:30)

A strengths and evidence-based assessment tool to measure the care quality parents or carers give a child. Graded Care Profile 2 (GCP2) helps professionals measure the quality of care provided by a parent or carer in meeting their child's needs. Using the GCP2 assessment tool, professionals grade aspects of family life on a scale of one to five. This helps them identify areas where the level of care children receive is good and where it could be significantly improved. Professionals can then provide guidance and/or interventions, or signpost or refer on to the most appropriate supporting agency. **Book your place with Trafford Strategic Safeguarding Partnership here: tssp.learning@trafford.gov.uk**
